## IMPORTANT!

### OCTOBER 2023

October kicks off fundraising for the season! **Every family is required to raise \$350** worth of fundraising yearly (see "Fundraising Information" attachment or visit the "for parents" page on our website for the breakdown) If you are unable to raise your required amount, **the first payment of \$175 will be processed on December 20th.**

We'll be hosting a **used dress and athletic wear sale** on Sunday, October 15th. You'll be able to order your new **club jackets** (measurements need to be taken) and purchase used club jackets and other figure skating clothing. *Email with pricing coming soon!*

Volunteering roles have started and we're so thankful for the support of our EESC families. Those signed up for roles each month be contacted at the beginning of the month to arrange your volunteer date. If you're unable to complete your requirement, the **first volunteer payment of \$125 will be processed on December 20th.**

We're a full month in and competition's are already under way. As well, we are starting to plan for assessments for Star 1 and up. Please note: Assessment fees have been raised from \$12 to \$15 per assessment.

### JAN-MAR 2024

Due to lower enrolment of figure skaters on Sundays, we will be amending the schedule for January 2024. See "January - March Sunday Schedule".

### AUGUST 2024

2024 Casino! A casino is the backbone for funding in our club. Ice is up to \$20,000 per month. A Casino draws up to \$80,000 in funds to help keep fees down for EESC skaters. **Every family is required to volunteer 1** shift. Any shifts completed after your 1 required shift earn you \$100 towards ice fees.

For Example:

1st shift - casino requirement met

2nd shift - \$100 credit applied to your 2024-2025 EESC account

3rd shift - \$100 credit applied to your 2024-2025 EESC account





# FUNDRAISING INFORMATION 1/2

ALL **EESC Members are required to fundraise** for the 2023-2024 season. Fundraising fees are due December 20th and June 20th. Fundraising questions can be forwarded via email to our Fundraising Chair, Angie Lisowski, lina03ca@yahoo.ca. Fundraising **requirements are per per family**, this means 1 or 3 skaters means the same fundraising requirement. Please see the note below from our fundraising coordinator.

## Fundraising towards your required \$350:

Hi Skaters and Families! It's that time of the year!

My name is Angie Lisowski, mother to Danielle and Nicole - I am your fundraising coordinator. We have opportunities to raise funds to fulfill your fundraising commitment for this season, and raise money to go towards your skaters ice fees.

The total fundraising requirement is \$350 for the year which is split into two payments of \$175. Any funds raised over and above the \$350 will go into the Extreme Edge Parent Fund Account. Those extra funds raised can be used towards anything skating related (ice fees, coaching fees, purchase of skating apparel, etc). Just contact me to access the funds and have a cheque made on your behalf.

These fundraising opportunities are for Jr. Prep, Junior, Intermediate A/B, and Senior skaters.

1)  Stawnichy's Mundare Sausage

2)  Mom's Pantry (Cookies & Muffins)

Delivery will be beginning of December. I will notify you of exact date later.

Please note: the amount of profit you make on each item sold is what counts towards your fundraising total, not the total price sold. **See fundraising information 2/2 to learn more.**

3)  FlipGive App

FlipGive is an online platform that helps groups, like sports teams or schools, raise money by shopping at popular stores. You simply download the app, load your in-app wallet to shop and earn \$\$ back!

Imagine you want to raise funds for your child's skating club. Instead of asking for donations, you can use FlipGive. We have created a club page and can invite supporters to shop through FlipGive at various stores. When you make purchases, the buyer uses the app (like collecting points), and a dollar amount of their spending goes back to the club as cashback or a donation. For example, if I spent \$150 every month on groceries until May 30th, I would make a minimum of \$100 in fundraising, just by purchasing necessities for my family. Download the app and start raising now. **Use code YGDGTS to connect and fundraise for EESC!**

# FUNDRAISING INFORMATION 2/2

## Junior Prep - Junior - Intermediate - Senior

### Stawnichy's Mundare Sausage

For each item sold, a profit of \$2.50 will be made to go towards the \$175 Fundraising Requirement

- Ex) 10 items sold = \$25.00 towards fee requirement
- 20 items sold = \$50.00 towards fee requirement
- 30 items sold = \$75.00 towards fee requirement

### Mom's Pantry Cookies & Muffins

For each cookie and muffin order, a profit of 35% will be made. Each order is \$25.00, you will make \$8.75 per sale towards \$175 Fundraising Requirement

- Ex) 10 items sold = \$87.50 towards fee requirement
- 20 items sold = \$175.00, covers entire fee requirement

Garlic Spread and Cinnamon Spread, each offer a 40% profit if sold. Each of the spreads sell for \$9.90 each, you will make \$3.96 per sale

- Ex) 10 items sold = \$39.60 towards fee requirement
- 20 items sold = \$79.20 towards fee requirement
- 30 items sold = \$118.80 towards fee requirement

### Flip Give App

EESC members must download the Flip Give app, create an account and enter code: **YGDGTS**. Once you've done that, you can buy in-app giftcards for gas, groceries, and more! ## Volunteering

ALL EESC Members are **required to complete at total of 8 volunteer credits** for the season. 4 credits prior to December 20th (\$125), and 4 credits prior to June 20th (\$125). **Signing up for shifts is located through member accounts** on our website. ## EESC Membership

2023-2024 Club membership includes the Skate Canada membership fee. Club memberships cover the cost of travel time, hotels and mileage for coaches attending competitions and assessment day fees for judges. As well as various other expenses incurred throughout the year.

## Casino

EESC is granted a casino every 2-3 years. This is a HUGE fundraiser, up to \$150,000.00 + to cover the cost of ice. We have been granted a casino for our 2023-2024 skating season, **date/time TBD**. All Members are expected to work a minimum of 1 shift. Once this is completed, your \$300 Casino deposit is removed from your member account. The first shift is required, any additional shifts worked by friends or family 18+ earn a \$100 ice credit towards the 2024-2025 skating season. **Members who choose not to work their shift are charged their \$300 Casino deposit**. This deposit will be used to cover the cost of paying a city of Edmonton civilian to work that shift (we are required to fill 40 shifts)
