Parent Conduct towards Fellow Skaters/Coaches/Administration/Officials

Thank you for including your athlete in the Learn To Skate program at **Extreme Edge Skating Club (EESC)**. Our Club is fortunate to have individuals who allow their children the opportunity to be involved in extra-curricular activities. Your child(ren) will develop more than athletic skills: learning for fun, resiliency, respect, dedication, camaraderie, teamwork, sportsmanship, and empathy. However, these benefits would be lost without a combined effort to make this experience as positive as possible for all parties involved.

Our coaches and administrative staff dedicate a tremendous amount of time and energy, providing the opportunity for your child(ren) to experience skating. EESC staff continually challenge themselves to improve on program delivery, technical enhancements and overall performance.

To assist in the delivery of a positive environment, EESC staff would like to remind Parents of the following general rules of conduct in public areas of the facility or venues:

Expectations of all EESC Parents

1. Do communicate to coaches and ask questions about your skater(s)!
2. Refrain from the use of rude or obnoxious comments/behavior towards members of the team, other parents, officials, EESC staff and/or athletes.
3. You have a right to inquire about your son/daughter after skating lessons. However, you do not have the right to comment about other skater(s) without corrective action being requested.
4. While occupying any viewing areas, front entrance or common areas please refrain from disruptive behaviors', loud noises or negative comments towards members of EESC, coaches, athletes and/or staff. Dressing rooms and hallways are safe spaces for our programming - these are not play areas for family members.

IN THE EVENT OF PROBLEMS OR UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR, THE PROGRAM DIRECTORS RESERVE THE RIGHT:

- a) To request the parent(s) immediately remove themselves from the facility/venue.
- b) To withdraw any skater from programming without refund.
